This price does *not* include casket, outer burial container, flowers, memorial items, honorariums, cemetery expenses, monument and/or marker, any other cash advance items, or any applicable sales tax.

**PAYMENT POLICY:** To lose someone you love is a heartbreaking experience. It is frequently traumatic and can seriously impact judgment. We believe in the importance of the recognition and meaningful celebration of a life that has been lived and will assist in arranging an appropriate service to meet your individual needs.

It is also important to be realistic with respect to funeral expenditures and payment expectations. We do not want a family to spend more than they are comfortable with, nor less than they would like. What is important is that the arrangements satisfy the family's wishes and budget.

## ITEMIZED SELECTIONS

However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods, funeral services, burial site goods, and/or burial site services you selected.

### Basic Services of Funeral Director

and Staff\* ..... \$ 1,840

Our fee for the services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family or responsible party; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance and utility expenses, secretarial and administrative costs, and equipment and inventory expenses.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. *This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving of remains.*

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial, or when refrigeration or use of dry ice is available.

**Forwarding of Remains to Another Funeral Home**

This charge includes transfer of remains, necessary services of staff, embalming, necessary authorizations, and local transportation (but not shipping charges). This charge does not include visitation, rites or ceremonies prior to forwarding of the body.

**Direct Cremation.....\$ 1,840– \$ 5,350**

Our charge for a direct cremation without any attendant rites or ceremonies includes transfer of remains, necessary services of staff and authorization. Minnesota law does not require you to purchase a casket for cremation. If you want to arrange a cremation, you can use a cremation container. A cremation container is a combustible, closed container that encases the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or corrugated cardboard and into which a dead human body is placed prior to insertion into a cremation chamber for cremation. The containers we provide are heavy cardboard. *Our price for Direct Cremation includes the crematory fee.*

### Readings
